#### What does it all mean?

- Lower Mainland** LM brevets accounted for 46% of the schedule but 60% of the total club distance.  
 LM riders at 64% of active riders accounted for 72% of the total club distance ridden.  
 LM riders rode 96% of the LM distance and also accounted for 42% of the Island distance and almost 15% of the Interior distance  
 No single rider in the LM accounted for more than 6.5% of the total LM distance
- Vanc. Island** VI brevets accounted for 38% of the schedule but only 30% of the club distance despite offering an international 2000km event.  
 VI riders at 16.5% of active riders accounted for 17% of the total club distance ridden  
 VI riders accounted for minimal distance in other regions (less than 5%)  
 Over 22% of the VI total distance was ridden by 1 rider, top 3 riders accounted for 44% of total VI distance
- Interior** Int.brevets accounted for 7% of the club distance scheduled and almost 8% of the distance ridden.  
 Int. riders are 12% of active members with the top 5 riders accounting for 37% of the distance ridden in this region.
- Peace Region** PR riders supported their series well despite small numbers.  
 \* We should try to encourage club members to visit the Peace for a ride.
