It was moved, seconded and carried to adopt the minutes of the Jun 11 meeting as prepared.

Agenda Items:

<u>Regional Route Coordinator's Report – Southern Interior</u> – Reported by Bob Goodison There was only one rider for the Barkerville 1000 km, and he (I) DNFed due to heat, humidity and poor planning. The route is a good one and will be even better once the highway construction north of 70 Mile House is completed. I am considering offering this same route in 2014, possibly on the Labour Day weekend.

The routes are posted and Randopony is open for the Interior make up rides on July 20. The new 200 km route is particularly nice. I am planning to do a pre ride of the make up 600 on July 13.

There is a tentative plan to run the Mica Dam 300km as our spring 300 in 2014 if enough people are interested. Organizer and volunteers are already on board.

<u>Regional Route Coordinator's Report – Vancouver Island</u> – Mike Croy Very little to report. There were fast times on the summer 200 and 300.

<u>Regional Route Coordinator's Report – Lower Mainland</u> - Reported by Keith Nichol and Gary Baker The routes are coming in for the summer rides. While Keith is away riding LEL Gary will work with the route organizers. It would be useful to at least confirm the start and finish locations of upcoming rides so the riders can make plans, especially those riding to the start.

<u>President's Report</u> – Ryan Golbeck Nothing new to report.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Ross Nichol Income from Hell Week and most events has been received. All bills are paid and there are no problems.

Canada Day Recap

There were over 400 riders and many DNFs due to the heat. The new start location worked well. In future years the Chilliwack control may have to be moved because of traffic congestion.

Fleche rule to be clarified

We discussed the following wording in the June 11 meeting:

For two teams starting at the same location, at the same time. If the two teams are riding substantially the same route (overlap of more than one control), then the start times most be separated by at least one hour. This has been changed to:

In order to avoid teams from working together, teams must not ride together for extended periods. The organizer may request changes to either the route or the start time or both to avoid such overlap.
