Called to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>: Approved as prepared.

#### Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting:

It was moved, seconded and carried to adopt the minutes of the July 9 meeting as prepared.

Agenda Items:

President's Report – Ryan Golbeck

A request for nominations has been posted on the web site, the discussion list and the forum. Deirdre will send the same information directly to the members. An election officer needs to be in place by early September and needs to be present at the AGM.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Ross Nichol No report. The treasurer is away.

<u>Regional Route Coordinator's Report – Southern Interior</u> – Reported by Bob Goodison Constructive input has been received for next year's events. The Mica Dam 300 will be one of the routes and some people have already volunteered as organizers.

<u>Regional Route Coordinator's Report – Vancouver Island</u> – Mike Croy Preparations have begun for the VI1200 for 2014. John Lee Ellis will be contacted in order to coordinate the CanAm pin (for those who complete a 1200 in the US and Canada in the same year). Next year's schedule is being prepared.

### Regional Route Coordinator's Report - Lower Mainland - Reported by Keith Nichol

There were some complaints about the triple S LM200 route which a few riders found hard to follow. Organization for the summer 600 is underway. The sleep control will not be staffed. The organizer of the Labour Day 1000 will be asked to shorten the route. The current route has a distance of 1051 km which is considered too long especially for any slower riders.

Keith Nichol will start talking to the Seattle International Randonneurs to coordinate early spring rides.

### Other route information

Someone was asking for some Lower Mainland rides to start outside of the Metro Vancouver area however we have already received plenty of feedback from riders requesting that events start in town. Most of the Lower Mainland riders live in the Metro Vancouver area and many do not own cars so the preference continues to favour starts in the Metro Vancouver area.

Distance of routes

An effort should be made to ensure that routes be no longer 4% over the nominal distance for rides up to 400 km and no longer than 2% over the nominal distance for routes over 400 km.

### Handling DQs

The organizer can DQ a rider but the rider can appeal to the BC Randonneur committee. On the other hand, a rider can also request (anonymously) that another rider be DQed.

#### **Route Sheet Issues**

For our archives, the organizer should give Eric Fergusson a corrected route sheet after the event.

#### Information posted on the website in advance

At a minimum, at least the start location, the end location and a description of the route needs to be posted. Close to the event date the final route should be given to the web master for posting. When routes are posted, the posting date should be on the page so that it is clear to the riders if there have been any changes since they last reviewed the route.

#### Clothing and Club Branding - Chris Cullum

This item is complete for now. The website will slowly be transitioned to the new colours, logo, font etc. The current stock of clothing and items is sufficient. There may be a pre-order for shorts next year. The pricing from Louis Garneau was quite good and quite a bit cheaper than retail with low minimums. Basic black shorts with a blue/green thigh band and "BC Randonneurs".

<u>Constitution and Administrative Roles</u> Mike Croy and Gary Baker will get the process started.
