Called to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm

Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting:

It was moved, seconded and carried to adopt the minutes of the February meeting as prepared.

President's Report – Andy Reimer (by email)

- 1. Things went well at the Roger Street Memorial Ride. 21 riders at the start, 19 at the brewery. Having a food truck there was certainly a good idea (thanks Susan).
- Spring Social had 40+ attendance and a couple of new riders came out which is always good to see. It was inspiring to see three 40,000 Km awards and a 100,000 Km award. Jacques had the posters there and many were picked up, Chris managed to clear out a lot of the old clothing stock (much of it to me).
- 3. The website didn't get the big reveal. There are a few critical things to sort out. Étienne and I will be meeting next week.
- 4. The Lohn Caulder boardroom is unavailable for April & May an alternate location is required. (Colin will take this on.)

Treasurer's Report – Darren MacLachlan Bank account is healthy. Otherwise guiet.

Regional Route Coordinator's Reports

Southern Interior – Bob Goodison. All routes have been determined.

Vancouver Island – Mike Croy

Island Social event took place last Sunday. Well attended – about 30 including some young folks. This Saturday is the Chilly 200 – about 14 are pre-registered. Ride organizers are in place for all the scheduled. Note that the BC Day Populaire event has been cancelled & is off the calendar schedule.

Lower Mainland – Chris Cullum

Ride organizers are in place for all but the Summer 600 brevet. It seems to be getting tougher to find organizers – big thanks to Gary Baker for his recruitment efforts. Early Bird 200 pre-ride is up for this weekend.

Club Clothing Note: New style jerseys, shorts, bibs and reflective vests are fairly well stocked. There's still lots of wool socks, \$10 a pair. Wooleator socks are \$15+tax at MEC so these are a pretty good deal. Going forward much of the clothing will be on a pre-order basis to eliminate the excess stock, old styles and odd ball sizes that we tend to get stuck with.

Rocky Mountain 1200 Report – Jeff Mudrakoff

- 1. Full registration has been open for a while now.
- 2. 50 riders are paid-in-full registered somewhat lower than expected at this time.
- 3. Bob Koen is handling registration he will send 'prompt' emails to the uncommitted pre-registrants.
- 4. It is still early, but if the rider count looks to be below targeted, will produce a contingency budget
- 5. There will be a volunteer pre-ride. At least 10 riders have shown interest.
- 6. Route drive is still targeted for May.

Brunch is booked with Harrison resort for Sunday May 8 - \$700 deposit. 1 BR cabin (#6) booked for Fri/Sat nights (usual 2br booked since 2014) Bob & Patti Marsch have confirmed they will to manage the cabin again. I have asked Michel to MC again.
